SNACKS

- One portion of fresh fruit available for all Key Stage One children. Nursery, Reception, Years one and two every day.
- Milk is provided up until their 5th Birthday, should you wish to continue, you may order milk online for your child via Cool Milk. This can only be done at the beginning of each half term
- Toast can be ordered via the Evolve system, this must be completed by the first week of each term.

SCHOOL MEALS

- Menus are designed by Trafford
- We have cooks on site, preparing fresh food each day.
- All meals must be ordered by the Sunday for the following week.
- Packed lunches are also available to choose within the universal school meal option for key stage one children.
- Nursery full time places, must provide their own packed lunch.

EVOLVE – ONLINE PAYMENT SYSTEM

- All parents/carers must register their child on Evolve.
- You will receive a unique code for each child, the children can be linked for ease of access, plus detailed instructions. There is also a self help link on our website under the 'Parents tab.'
- All food allergens along with religious or dietary preferences must also be recorded. This is the Parent/Carers responsibility
- You can order food for the week ahead each Sunday, or if your prefer you can order for the whole of the half term.
- Please ensure you cancel meals for your child should they be off school for any reason prior to 9:00hrs.
- The on line system is also used to pay for activity within school as much as possible to ultimately achieve a cash less process.
