Curriculum Update

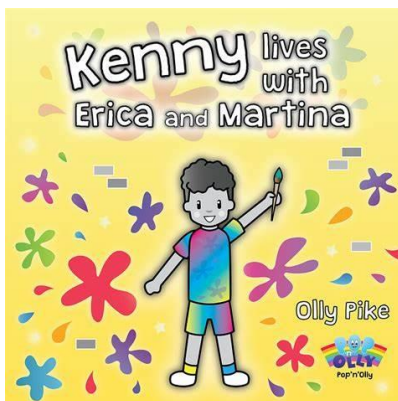
For the next half term our curriculum focus will be 'Marvellous Mountains'. This is an exciting Geography topic for us to study.
