Welcome to Year 3 2021-22

We are looking forward to welcoming the children into Year 3. We have an exciting year planned and we will keep you updated with our newsletter at the beginning of each half term. We will share this on Class Dojo and it will also be on the school website.

Our theme this half term is 'Water, Water Everywhere'. We will be learning about rivers in Geography and our English work will link with water themed texts. We will have daily Maths lessons covering place value and calculations for the first half term. In Science we will be learning how to carry out investigations, and develop our questioning skills to work scientifically. We will be starting to learn French beginning with greetings, numbers and colours.
