Topics

The Nursery children have settled back really well after Christmas and are very happy and enthusiastic. Our current topic is all about winter. In our topic the children will explore and talk about what happens in winter. The children will create a simple winter poem using their ideas. Our winter poem will be all about what the children can see, hear and feel in winter. The main text we will focus on in our winter topic is 'What Happens in Winter' and 'Owl Babies'. The children will discuss the story setting, events and characters within the story. Our next learning topic for this half term is space. Our focus next will be 'Whatever Next' written by the author Jill Murphy.

In our Phonics inputs this half term the children will consolidate the letter sound they already know and will continue to learn some new letters sounds. The children will practise writing and linking the sounds they learn, to the initial sounds in simple words. The children will continue to practise their listening and rhyming skills through circle time activities and games.

In Maths we will be focusing on numbers and quantities within 5. We will practise ordering numerals and focus on counting a given number of objects within 5 accurately. We will continue to practise counting forwards and backwards from any given number daily within our carpet time inputs.

Illness

If your child is poorly with sickness or diarrhoea please keep them at home for at least 48 hours after the last bout, until they are well.
